General Instructions

- **Students requesting early dismissal during exams must submit requests by Friday, 1/18, 8am. All early dismissal requests during exam week must be approved by the principal in advance.**
- No food or drink in the classrooms without permission from the principal.
- Students will be given EXACTLY 120 minutes to take exams. This does not include time for the distribution or collection of materials. Ten minutes have been added to the beginning and ending of the Exam Block, and a single bell chime will signal the start and end of testing time.
- Students are not to be dismissed until the end of each period WHEN THE DUAL BELL CHIME RINGS.
- All lunch study sessions, club/class meetings, etc. are suspended during exam week. This will provide time for students to meet with teachers, as needed.
- Make ups for missed exams will be on Thursday, 1/31, unless otherwise arranged; location TBD.

Special Instructions

1. Students making up missed exams on Thursday, 1/31, will follow modified schedule. See your counselor for details regarding makeup exams.
2. Students who miss more than one day of exams will need to make additional arrangements. Please notify the guidance counselor and principal as soon as possible.
3. The following special considerations need to be made:
 - a. Spanish students would need to take the oral portion of their test at lunch unless the teacher has an administrative duty period when the student is making up the exam. Any Spanish teacher who needs to be relieved of their lunch duty to administer the oral section of the exam will be provided coverage.
 - b. Students who have questions during the exam should be instructed to mark those areas until the teacher is able to see the student during their administrative duty period or at extra help during the lunch period.
